Here is the faucet with all the parts on the handle side unscrewed:



If you look carefully, you will see two washers in here. Make sure not to lose those. One fits down into the faucet, the other into that collar piece that unscrews:

On the shank side of the assembly, you will see a spring. The narrow side of that spring goes into the faucet:



There is also a rubber washer inside of the end of the faucet to keep it from leaking:
